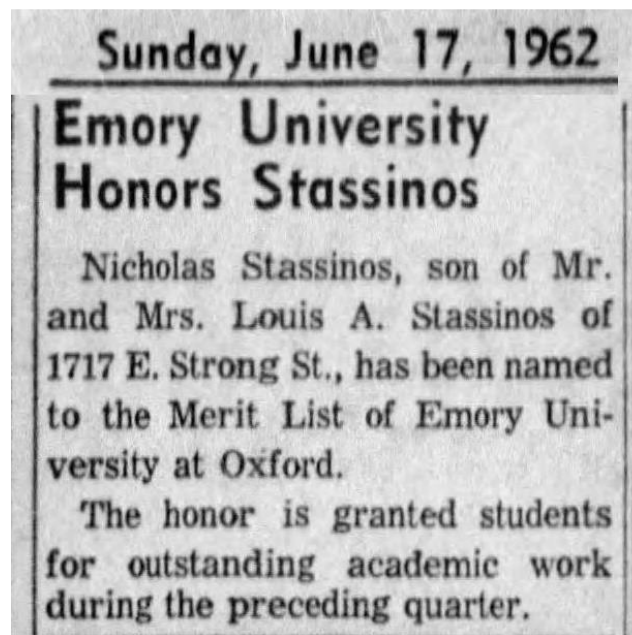


NICHOLAS "NIKOS" STASSINOS
