Heather Yvonne Moore, 29, of Pensacola died Friday night, May 7, 1999 from injuries she sustained as a direct result of a motor vehicle accident.

Heather was a native and life long resident of Pensacola and graduated from Washington High School in 1987. She attended Pensacola Junior College and was a graduate of the University of West Florida, where she received a degree in social services. She was employed at Albertson's on Nine Mile Road and was a member of Heights Baptist Church. Heather was a certified lifeguard and was always willing to help other people.

Heather was preceded in death by her mother, Patricia Woodcock Moore in September of 1998.
