His mother died on December 23, 1963. and Robert attended her funeral. In 1964, age 22, Robert was involved in a "Wild Auto" accident, in which he was charged with failure to have his vehicle under control. An automobile careened out of control for an entire city block early this morning, wrecking three other automobiles and finally smashing into a house.

Patrolman John L. Mandel said Robert Holifield, 22, of 3206 E. Gonzalez St., lost control of his car as he was driving north on Alcaniz Street near the Wright Street intersection.

Mandel said Holifield's car struck a car parked on the right hand side of the road, knocking it 18 feet. Holifield's car then veered to the left hand side of the road, striking another car and turning it over on the sidewalk.

Mandel said Holified's vehicle skidded 42 feet further to hit a third parked car and then skidded 107 feet more into a house.
