

RUTH RUNYAN (THORNTON) ROGERS  
June 22, 1943 – March 11, 2005



Ruth T. Rogers, 61, of Pensacola, passed away Friday, March 11, 2005. Mrs. Rogers was a native of Lexington, KY, and had resided in Pensacola most of her life. She was a member of the Daughters of American Revolution; Colonial Dames of the 17<sup>th</sup> Century; and was a Kentucky Colonel. Mrs. Rogers was also a member of Alpha Gamma Delta, Kappa Delta Pi and Phi Beta Sigma sororities.

She retired with 30 years of service as The Administrative Librarian with NAMI (National Alliance on Mental Illness).
